KEDAR TAL FIXED DEPARTURE



Kedar Tal is a high altitude trek from Gangotri. Situated about 17km away from Gangotri and at an altitude of 4912m above sea level, this trek is both physically and mentally challenging and is definitely not meant for beginners. The destination offers stunning views of the Jogin massif, Thaley sagar, Bhiringupant & Manda. The 17km trek is spread over 5 days owing to its altitude and trail.

RAG believes in providing special attention to each of its guests and hence, unlike other trekking / expedition organizations, does not conduct its fixed departures with large number of people in a group. A typical expedition group would consist of 4-10 members.

COST: INR 15000 for a group of minimum 5 members

Altitudes you should be aware of:

- Gangotri – 3048m
- Bhoj Kharak – 3780m
- Kedar Kharak – 4280m
- Kedar Tal – 4780m

DAY 1- GANGOTRI (5 to 6hr):

Arrive at Gangotri we'll help you check in to your hotel / Tourist guest house. In the evening you will witness the Ganga Arati again and the worship of the goddess in the temple.

DAY 2- GANGOTRI TO BHOJ KHARK(5 to 6hr):

We wake up early today and after breakfast, we embark on our trek to Bhoj Kharak. The trek to Bhoj Kharak is a steep ascent right from the start. After an hour's climb we traverse the Kedar gorge to reach Bhoj Kharak. The entire trek is along the Kedar Ganga, through fir (cedus) and Bhoj (birch) trees. The bark of birch was used as paper for writing ancient manuscripts in India. Today, we'll set our camps here.

DAY 3- BHOJ KHARAK TO KEDARKHARAK (4 to 5hr):

Today we leave the tree line and trek through a long meadow with the Bhagirathi peak in the backdrop. We arrive at Kedar Kharak and camp near a gushing stream in the meadow. Overnight in camp.

DAY 4 - KEDAR KHARAK TO KEDAR TAAL (4 to 5hr):

It's going to be challenging today! The trek is very steep and through boulders and stones. However, this grueling climb is worth the effort as we are soon greeted by the pristine and crystal clear waters of the Kedar Tal. You can see the Thaleysagar peak from here with its reflection in the lake. We set our camps here.



DAY 5 - KEDAR TAAL TO BHOJ KHARAK (5 to 6hrs):

Wake up early today if you do not want to miss the spectacular sunrise! After breakfast, we trace your steps back to Bhoj kharak via Kedarkharak where we stop for lunch. Overnight in camp.

DAY 6 - BHOJKHARAK TO GANGOTRI (6 to 7hrs):

Today, we start trekking down to Gangotri . After reaching, we'll help you check into a hotel/guest house.

Inclusions / Exclusions

All our treks are staffed by experienced mountaineering guides, porters and cooks.

The expedition will cover the following:

1. Accommodation in guest houses, hotels, tents from Gangotri to Gangotri on a double occupancy basis.
2. All meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner) during the trek. Meals from Gangotri and onward will be strictly vegetarian.
3. All permission related paper work and charges.
4. Porter charges (Guests can offload their luggage up to a maximum of 10kg per person. For every extra 5kg, an additional charge of Rs 500 per day will be levied.)
5. Kitchen Tent, Dining Tent, Toilet Tent.
6. Sleeping bags, mattresses
7. First Aid / Medical kit including Oxygen cylinder

The expedition does not include the following:

1. Any expenses of a personal nature such as laundry, telephone bills, Insurance, Tips etc.
2. Costs arising due to unforeseen circumstances such as landslides, bad weather or things beyond our control.

Booking Procedure:

To book a trek, please send us an email at realadventuregangotri@gmail.com with the Subject Line Fixed Departure <Trek Name> <Date dd/mm/yyyy>. You will receive a response from us via email with our Bank Details. Your booking will stand confirmed as soon as we receive the booking amount as mentioned below.

- 50% of the total cost (INR 7500) must be paid as a booking amount 45days prior to the trek departure.
- The remaining 50% must be paid on arrival before the trek departure.

Cancellation Policy:

- Refund of 95% of the total expedition cost for Cancellations made >30days prior to the expedition departure date.
- Refund of 50% of the total expedition cost for Cancellations made between 30 and 15 days prior to the expedition departure date.
- No refund for Cancellations made <15 days prior to the expedition departure date.
